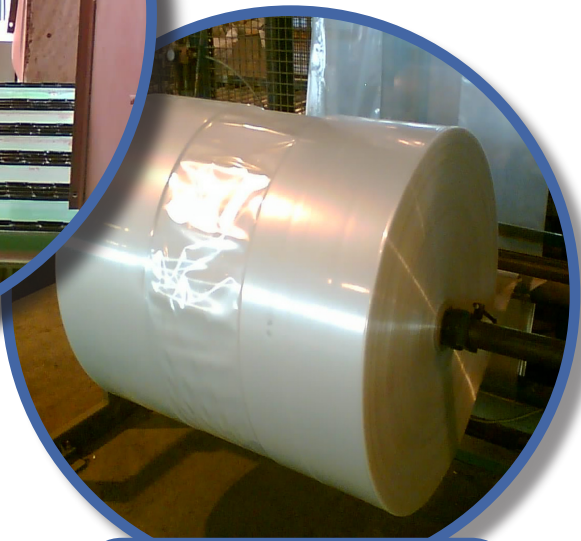
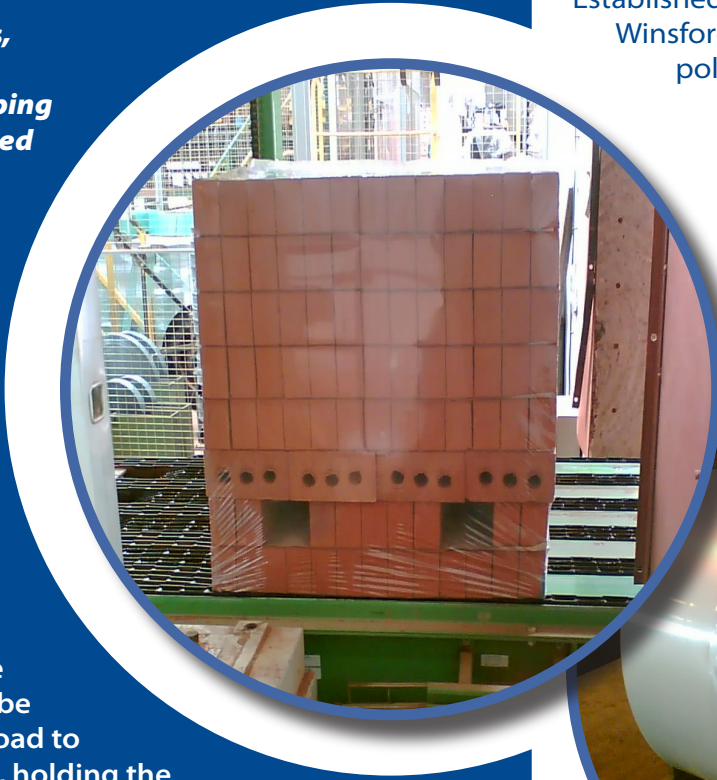
Over recent years, developments in alternative wrapping equipment have led to systems that are based on **stretching** rather than **shrinking covers** over palletised loads.

This system (termed "**stretch hood**") utilises a film with a high elasticity.

This elastic nature allows the film to be stretched over a load to snap back tightly, holding the load when released.

Britton Taco has worked closely with both materials and machinery suppliers to offer a range of films with consistent performance suitable for use on all the major wrapping units. One film size will wrap a number of pallet formats.
